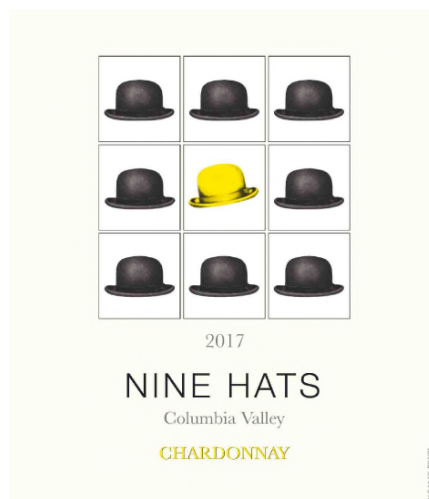




NINE HATS WINES



Long Shadows Vintners winemaker, Gilles Nicault, and founder, Allen Shoup, have been experimenting with the Columbia Valley's top vineyards to produce a style of Chardonnay they both enjoy. Complex, expressive and beautifully balanced, this wine is 100% barrel fermented in French oak.

Elegant and inviting with vibrant aromatics of fresh jasmine, white peach and hints of baking spice. Flavors of dry apricots and quince highlight a creaminess on the palate that is well balanced by the wine's lively acidity.

The 2017 Nine Hats Chardonnay was sourced primarily from the Yakima Valley's French Creek and Boushey vineyards. It is a cooler AVA that helps retain the Chardonnay's acidity and elegance. The wine was aged for 9 months on the lees in French oak barrels and cement eggs.
